

EBBERSTON WITH YEDINGHAM PARISH COUNCIL

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Minutes of the Meeting of Ebberston with Yedingham Parish Council held in Ebberston Village Hall on 09/07/2018 commenced at 7.00pm

PRESENT: Cllrs L Bowes (Chair), I Newman, F Wood, D Powlesland, and Mrs L Myers the clerk.
Members of the Public: 1 parishioner attended.

1. Welcome to all.
2. Election of the Chair – Cllr Bowes was proposed by Cllr Newman and seconded by Cllr Powlesland. Agreed by all
3. **Apologies:** Cllrs I Langford, Cllr P Evans and Cllr M Eyre.
4. **Open Forum** – Accident in Children’s Playground. This had been reported to the Council and shared with the Sports field Committee. A plate from an old motor bike rocker had become exposed due to the dry weather and caused an injury to a child’s knee. The plate has now been covered with soil.
5. **Declaration of Interests** – none declared.
6. **Minutes of the meeting** on Monday 14/05/2018 were agreed proposed by Cllr Powlesland and seconded by Cllr Newman, agreed by all present and signed by the chair.
7. **To Receive information on ongoing issues and decide further action**
 - 7.1 **Yedingham Allotments** – Land registry ongoing. No further information. Cllr Powlesland feels that they need to get more residents involved.
 - 7.2 **Ebberston Beck Group** – chaffer wood bunds. These have been installed. No further information received from Highways – to follow up again.
 - 7.3 **Traffic in Yedingham** – Village Gates considered. To investigate exact costs and designs. To request the speed van again.
 - 7.4 **Land registry CL365 CL366 Sandsprunt Lane and Scarth Lane** – Cllr Langford to investigate – no further information.
 - 7.5 **Shepherds Hut at Manor Farm cottages** – no further information.
 - 7.6 **Highways Issues** – Drains have been cleaned in Main Street and high street Yedingham. Slow signs in Back Lane Ebberston need repainting again, to report. Parishioner concern about the state of the road edges and footpaths with weeds. The road sweeper has been in the village in the last month. To request the road verges are sprayed.
 - 7.7 **Grass cutting** - there have been several concerns from Parishioners about the length of the grass and the number of cuts. There was a long discussion but the majority of Councillors decided that the current 6 cuts a year is sufficient. This will be reviewed in autumn.
 - 7.8 **Dog waste bin**, end of Pennistone Lane. This is broken and held together by a cable tie. Cllr Eyre has looked at it but could not repair it. To investigate with Cllr Wood.
8. **PLANNING Applications received**
 - 8.1 18/00326/FUL Providence Inn. Change of use of part of land rear to the public House to a camping caravan site for touring caravans/tents on 6 plots. There are no objections to these plans. There are concerns that there are currently more caravans on the site than the proposed planning allows. The static caravan is still in situ.
 - 8.2 18/00477/LBC ST Mary’s Cottage. Hag Side Lane, Ebberston YO13 9PA. External alterations, Erection of timber framed glass extension to replace existing one. Repointing of several walls, replacing sand and cement with Lime mortar mix. Replacement of 6 quoins, re render one wall. No objections from Councillors.

9.1 18/00258/ADV Providence Inn. Yedingham. Signs and lighting. Approved by RDC

10. FINANCIAL MATTERS

10.1 Finance report June 2018 including payments and receipts. This was presented by the Clerk and agreed.

10.2 Sports field Accounts were shared with the Council. It was confirmed that Cllr Bowes and Cllr Eyre are the Parish Council representatives. Seats on see saw and swings to be replaced. They are investigating grants for equipment. The bridge has been repaired.
