1. Welcome to all.
2. **Apologies:** Cllrs. L Bowes, I Langford and D Powlesland
3. **Open Forum – 7.2** The Council was thanked by a Parishioner for their efforts in attempting to prevent the flooding down the street. The results since the Beck has been cleaned out and the Bunds have been put in Chaffer Wood has been positive. Only time will tell if it has been effective.
