Minutes of the Meeting of Ebberston with Yedingham Parish Council held in Ebberston Village Hall on 14/01/2019 commenced at 7.00pm

1. Welcome to all.
2. Cllr F Wood. The Chair sadly informed the Council that one of the longest serving Councillors, Frank Wood died on the 27th December. Frank served the Parish for over 30 years and his death will be a great loss to the Council and the village. His knowledge of the local area and the history of the village were invaluable to us. Our thoughts are with Grace, his wife of 40 years and son John and his family. A donation of £100 has been received by the Council to put towards a memorial for Cllr. Wood, the suggestion of a group of trees has been put forward. To meet with Grace and family to discuss what they would like.

John Stockdale's quote was accepted.
